

CORON ADVENTURE TOURS

A. CORON ISLAND ADVENTURE TOUR

Duration: 6-7 hours by outrigger

Destinations: Kayangan Lake, Twin Lagoon, Skeleton Wreck, Atwayan Beach

Rates: Php 3,900 net/person inclusive of lunch
Php 3,400 net/person inclusive of snack
Child rate (3 to 6 years old): PHP 2,200 net/child (lunch or snack)

Note: Guests must be physically fit to climb to Kayangan Lake

B. CORON ISLAND ULTIMATE TOUR

Duration: 7-8 hours by outrigger

Destinations: Siete Pecados, Kayangan Lake, Twin Lagoon, Barracuda Lake, Skeleton Wreck, Atwayan Beach

Rates: Php 4,400 net/person inclusive of lunch
Php 3,900 net/person inclusive of snack
Child rate (3 to 6 years old): PHP 2,600 net/child (lunch or snack)

Note: Guests must be physically fit to climb to Kayangan Lake

C. MALCAPUYA ISLAND DAY TRIP

Duration: Variable, depending on guests preference

Destination: Malcapuya Island

Rates: Php 3,300 net/person inclusive of lunch

E. SANGAT, LUSONG WRECKS, PASS ISLAND TOUR

Duration: 6-7 hours by outrigger

Destinations: Sangat Gunboat Wreck, Lusong Shipwreck, and Pass Island

Rates: Php 3,800 net/person inclusive of lunch
Php 3,000 net/person inclusive of snack
Child rate (3 to 6 years old): PHP 1,900 net/child (lunch or snack)

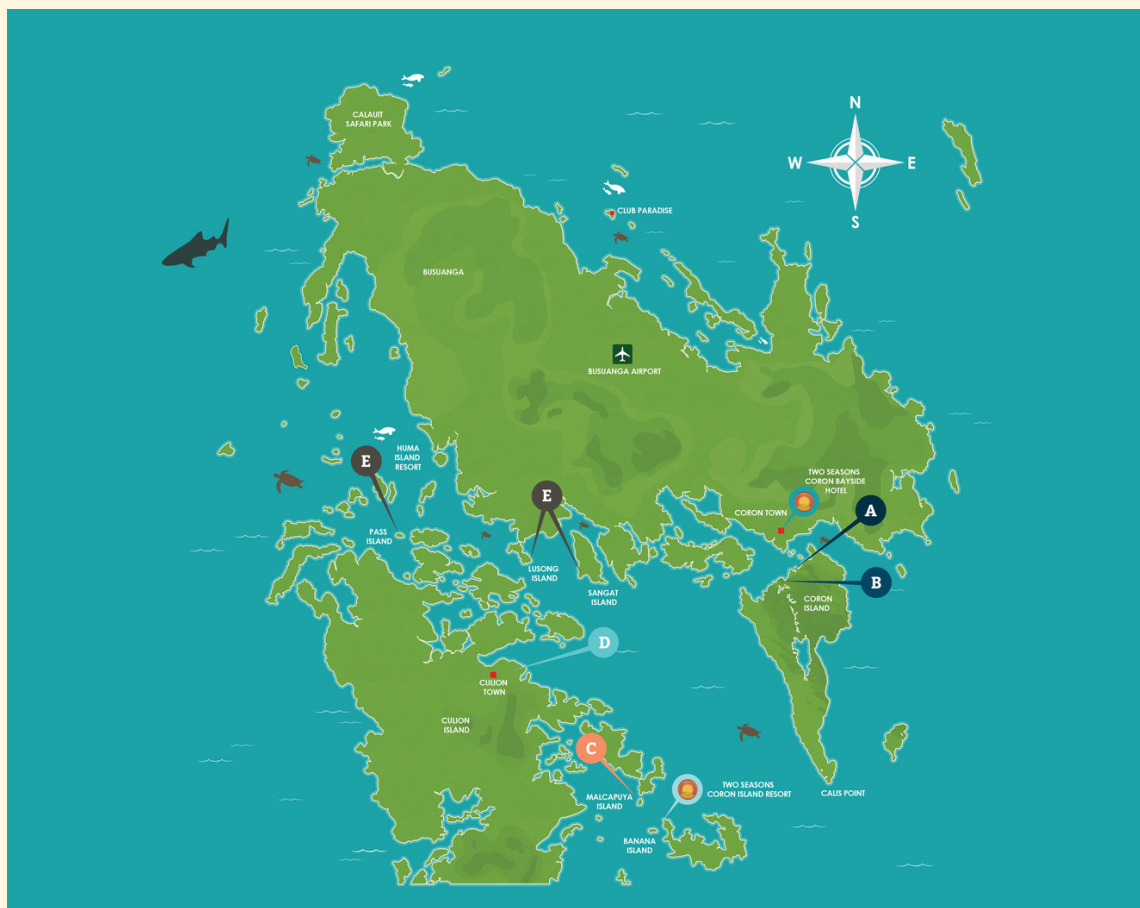

CORON WONDERS

Kayangan Lake – Hailed as one of the cleanest in the country and known for its crystal clear water. Cradled by limestone cliffs, this lake has become the flagship destination of Coron. Truly, your vacation will never be complete without a visit to this attraction.

Twin Lagoon – The first of the 2 lagoons is where boats dock, while the second one is hidden and can be accessed by walking on a man-made bridge. Or, if you are a thrill seeker, you may choose to dive underneath a rock and swim a good 3-meter distance.

Skeleton Wreck–This is one of the most popular snorkeling spot in Coron Bay. It is 5 to 22 meters deep.

Siete Pecados – This is a small protected sanctuary that is best known for snorkeling, with its fascinating underwater world adorned with stunning corals.

Barracuda Lake – This can sound intimidating or even frightening to some. But this gem, which is the second lake in Coron that is open to the public, reveals a fascinating surprise as soon as you put your mask on and plunge in. Surrounded by towering cliffs is a fresh water lake, which is a bit salty and brackish because of its proximity to the sea.

Atwayan Beach –Ideal for picnics, sun bathing, and leisurely dips, this destination boast an intimate setting and a stretch of the most inviting white sand.

Malcapuya Island – A short boat ride is all it takes for you to reach Malcapuya Island from our resort in Malaroyroy. It features a white sand beach, remarkable snorkeling sites, and shallow waters. Rest huts are also available.

Culion Island – The island of Culion looks like a regular town, but its history of struggle proves that it is anything but ordinary. For over a century, the town was a leper colony, which at one point was the biggest and most organized in the world. But since the development of the multi-drug therapy, a new era has dawned on this sanctuary. Don't leave the island without going to Culion Museum and Archives for a greater understanding of the illness that once shrouded the town. Another attraction you may visit is the Aguila View point, where you may enjoy a breathtaking view of Culion and the nearby islets.

Sangat and Lusong Shipwreck – The WWII Lusong Shipwreck is nicely covered with hard corals and features a wide variety of marine species. Perfect for snorkelers, the stern breaks the surface at low tide with a maximum bow depth of only 12 meters. Meanwhile, Sangat Gunboat Wreck, which lies at 3 meters below the surface, is great for snorkeling.

Pass Island – The picturesque Pass Island features pristine white sand beach, turquoise waters, stunning coral reef and giant clam sanctuary. Aside from swimming and snorkeling, the island is also an ideal place for picnic lunch and relaxation.
